In our view Volunteer PVG's should remain free, not be discounted. Volunteer involving organisations do not get full cost recovery to pay for volunteers. Even if a volunteer involving organisation was going to reimburse a volunteer the volunteer would have to pay the cost up front then be reimbursed. This creates a financial barrier for volunteers. It would create more of a barrier for volunteers to pay up front and not have this reimbursed. Some insurers ask for a PVG refresher every few years which would add further costs. Volunteers often have a trial period and during this selection period if it didn't work out for either party, the conversation around exit at that early stage becomes more difficult if the volunteer has paid to become involved. At a time when we need to make it easier for people to volunteer, this proposal makes it harder and is likely to put people off volunteering.
